Paul R. Greenwood

Deputy District Attorney for the San Diego Attorney's Office, Paul Greenwood has been a lawyer for over 25 years. He spent 13 years in England as a barrister and solicitor before relocating to San Diego in 1991. He joined the San Diego DA's office in 1993 and started the Elder Abuse Prosecution Unit in January 1996. Under his leadership the unit has grown to a team of twelve. He has also been involved in the prosecution of over 200 felony elder abuse cases. Mr. Greenwood is currently co-chair of the California District Attorneys Elder Abuse statewide committee and is an elected board member of the National Committee for the Prevention of Elder Abuse.

Robert B. Blancato

Bob is the National Coordinator of the Elder Justice Coalition, a non-partisan, 680 member coalition. From 2000-2006, Bob served as the President of the National Committee for the Prevention of Elder Abuse. He currently serves as the Executive Director of NANASP, the National Association of Nutrition and Aging Services Programs. Bob is a former House of Representatives Staff Member and spent 17 years on the House Select Committee on Aging. He also served as Executive Director of the 1995 White House Conference on Aging (WHCOA) appointed by President Clinton. Additionally, Bob was on the Policy Committee for the 2005 WHCOA, appointed by Rep. Nancy Pelosi.
